Tall ship sailing involves teamwork, adventure and strength of character. This is the platform off which we will explore the sea around us. This summer Gloucester Museum School Project Adventure Summer Camp is offering four opportunities for campers to embark on a fantastic voyage of discovery!

As the ship sails from Cape Ann, campers will spend their days and nights aboard the Tall Ship – Spirit of Massachusetts - actively involved in sailing the ship and they will be encouraged to realize their interdependence with the vessel, the natural environment, and each other.

The wind and weather will dictate the itinerary - Isles of Shoals, Stellwagen Bank, Salem Sound, Boston Harbor Islands, Cape Cod, and the eelgrass beds of Gloucester Harbor will be some of the many places we explore together.

The crew of ten are educators as well as sailors, so our ongoing learning discussions run the gamut of leadership, cooperation, marine science, weather, ships systems, engineering, navigation, sail theory, maritime and local history, life on board, and how a cook provisions for a multi day voyage for 30 persons.
